

Independent Contact Persons for the Examination of Suspected Cases (Unabhängige Ansprechpersonen für die Prüfung von Verdachtsfällen)

The Independent Contact Persons are the main point of contact for suspected cases of sexual abuse. Their task is to receive reports of sexual abuse and boundary violations or other sexual assault incidences against minors or vulnerable adults.

If reports of suspected cases occurred a long time ago, the Independent Contact Persons check the plausibility of the report and support those affected in applying for payments in recognition of their suffering. Therapy or legal costs can be covered.

In the case of reports of current suspected cases, the Independent Contact Persons are responsible for clarifying the suspected case. They are not employed by the Archdiocese of Munich and Freising, but work independently. They pass on information and instructions to the Archdiocese so that it can take the necessary action. If a criminal offense is suspected, the archdiocese always reports the matter immediately.
